

SADOFF & RUDOY INDUSTRIES, LLP MATERIAL ACCEPTANCE POLICY

Sadoff & Rudoy Industries, LLP is committed to the health and safety of its employees and customers as well as to conducting an environmentally safe and clean operation. Therefore, we cannot accept items that present a threat to human health or the environment. Such items include, but are not necessarily limited to, the following:

1. **CAPACITORS OR CAPACITOR BEARING MATERIALS:** Items that once contained capacitors will be accepted only if all capacitors have been removed (in compliance with all state and federal regulations), and the seller has supplied Sadoff with written certification of removal and indemnification. Non PCB bearing capacitors are acceptable if kept separate and delivered to the non-ferrous warehouse.
2. **BALLASTS OR ITEMS CONTAINING BALLASTS (PCB OR NOT):** Items that once contained ballasts will be accepted only if all ballasts have been removed (in compliance with all state and federal regulations), and the seller provides Sadoff with written certification of removal and indemnification. Non PCB bearing ballasts are acceptable if kept separate and delivered to the non-ferrous warehouse.
3. **LIGHT BULBS:** Including but not limited to fluorescent, neon, halogen, and incandescent.
4. **SEALED CONTAINERS:** Including but not limited to propane tanks, freon tanks, hydraulic cylinders, air tanks, and units under pressure or containing oils. Units are acceptable if cut open and properly cleaned.
5. **COMPRESSED GAS & OXYGEN BOTTLES:** Bottles will be accepted if drained, properly cleaned, and one end has been removed.
6. **LP TANKS:** Must be completely purged and/or shot blasted to remove all residual chemicals and cut in half.
7. **GAS TANKS:** Gas tanks will be accepted only if they are drained, punched with a minimum of six holes on each side, separate on a load, and arrangement has been made with a Sadoff buyer in advance of delivery.
8. **MICROWAVE OVENS – unless properly decommissioned.**
9. **TELEVISION SETS**
10. **TIRES:** Sadoff reserves the right to charge for the handling of tires mixed in a scrap load.
