1. Seller has reviewed and is familiar with the Sadoff & Rudoy Industries, LLP Material Acceptance Policy (Form GNO04).
2. Seller has carefully inspected or caused to be inspected each of the items delivered or caused to be delivered under this contract of sale including without limitation automobiles, appliances, refrigeration and air conditioning units, and similar equipment / components (the "Materials") and Buyer may rely on Seller's inspection.
3. None of the Materials contain:
 - a. Polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), including but not limited to any capacitor, ballast or other enclosed reservoir containing PCB-bearing liquids or residues;
 - b. Chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs), hydrochlorofluorocarbons (HCFCs), HFCs, PFCs or replacement refrigerants (e.g. HFC-134a), as defined in ' 608 of the Clean Air Act and 40 C.F.R. Part 82; or
 - c. Liquid mercury bearing devices, including but not limited to automobile switches (hood and trunk switches), appliance switches, temperature switches, pressure switches, or position/motion switches.
 - d. Hazardous substances, as defined by any federal, state or local law, statute, regulation, ordinance or standard (including but not limited to the definitions contained in 42 U.S.C. ' 9601 (14) and Wis. Stat. ' 292.01 (5)).
4. All remaining ozone-depleting refrigerants (CFCs and HCFCs) and replacement refrigerants (e.g. HFC-134a) that have not leaked previously have been properly transferred from any refrigeration or air conditioning device into storage tank, using approved recovery equipment, before delivery to Buyer, in compliance with Wis. Stat. ' 285.59 and Chapter NR 488, Wis. Admin. Code, by the licensed entity cited above. Records are available upon request.

5. Seller agrees to defend, indemnify and hold buyer harmless from and against any and all claims, liabilities, demands, penalties, fines, costs, expenses, or fees (including but not limited to reasonable attorney's and consultant's fees and expenses) in any way related to any breach of the above representations and warranties.
6. Seller understands and agrees that breach of any part of this representation may result in return to Seller of offered items (at Seller's expense), suspension/termination of current and/or subsequent purchase agreements, and/or other consequences at Sadoff's sole discretion.
